- A credit card sales service will be available for artists exhibiting at the show for 10% of the sale amount. The selling artist or a festival runner will take sales slip to gallery to process. Artists selling through the gallery will be paid in a week/or less following the show. A check will be mailed to the address on the application form.

Student Artist Program / Free

We will have a special student art section, to allow students the opportunity to exhibit and share their work. Schools, and/or individual students may set up a 10 x 10 booth/space. We will provide the tables and chairs. The students are responsible for creating the display area. Students may participate free of charge, and are allowed the same credit card charge service privileges as the show participants.

Requirements

- Artwork must be original in design and executed by the applicant. Reproductions must be clearly and individually labeled on the back with a brief description of the reproduction process.
- All artists must be present to display their own work. Proxy exhibitors are not permitted.
- Artists may only exhibit work in categories for which the work was juried and accepted.
- Displaying awards or ribbons from other shows is not allowed.
- No artwork from molds, kits, or other commercial mediums is allowed. Ready made objects (i.e., clothing, furniture, jewelry, string-a-bead), which have been embellished, painted, decorated, dyed, or batik will not be allowed.
- No individual music is allowed.
- No T-shirts may be sold at the festival.
- Artists who break down their displays or leave before closing on any day of the festival will not be allowed to return to future shows.
- Signage for each booth is required, displaying name or company.
- Work must be contained within the artists' booth space.
- Artists are responsible for keeping their area clean. Pull booth marker tape & discard.
- Artists are responsible for collecting and paying Texas Sales Tax.
- By signing the application, the artist agrees to all requirements, and may be asked to leave the

festival should any of these requirements not be met..

- An artist previously juried in a medium and accepted may show in that medium again without jurying again. Each additional new medium must be juried individually.

Application Checklist

- Completed and signed application form.
 - \$20 check for Jury Fee (**payable to River Art Gallery**) Jury fee is non-refundable and deposited upon receipt.
 - \$150 check for each booth space (**payable to River Art Gallery**). Booth Fee will be deposited upon acceptance. If you are not accepted, your check will be returned in the accepted/declined letter.
 - One S.A.S.E . for return of photos if desired.
 - 3 photos of each piece. Jpg. Photos may be e-mailed to: lindaapkarian@sbcglobal.net
 - Artist statement/biography.
 - Optional Credit Card payment information
