Award-winning San Antonio artist, Cindy Morawski, paints the subjects of landscapes, birds, and animals with pastels. A charter member and current President of the Texas Pastel Society, she has created art since childhood. Cindy also enjoys painting plein air landscapes outdoors with the Texas Pastel Society. Teaching and painting are two of her favorite things. An outdoor enthusiast, she tries to capture the light and colors of her subjects in nature within her compositions.

Her artist statement helps provide some personal insights. "I take artistic and spiritual inspiration from the natural world and then try to place it in a window for my viewer to appreciate. I want the viewer to feel as though they are standing where I am and looking out, appreciating the scene and feeling the awe in the goodness and beauty that nature provides."

Cindy's paintings can be found in four art galleries as well as in commercial and public spaces in downtown San Antonio: Yellow Rose Gallery of Rockport, Texas, River Art Gallery at LaVillita in downtown San Antonio, Granny M and Friends in Castroville, and Comfort Crockery in the Hill Country town of Comfort. Her public work has also been exhibited at the Alamo's Emily Morgan Hotel, Hotel Valencia on downtown's Riverwalk, Arthritis Associates in the Medical Area of San Antonio, and the Candlelight Coffeehouse and Wine Bar on N. St. Mary's Street in San Antonio. A recent addition has been the Mitchell Lake Audubon Center with her ArtBird Series.
